Welcome back!


As we return to dance and begin this “new temporary normal” in our studio, we understand that many families are concerned about safety as well as the changes to company policies and procedures that we are implementing. We want all families to be assured that we are taking concerns and the well-being of our employees and students seriously.

What we are doing:

- All employees, students, and visitors entering our buildings will be screened for COVID-19 symptoms and possible exposure including temperature taking.
- For now, our lobby will be closed except for parents needing assistance, ONE PARENT of our pre-school classes, or any first time students will be permitted. We are sorry no siblings allowed in the lobby at this time. We require all students and adults in our lobby to wear masks if staying to watch class. Parents may watch from zoom in your portal, please turn off your microphone and camera.
- Class sizes limited. At first, our dancers will dance in taped off boxes to promote social distancing during this early period of opening. Restrictions will be relaxed as we follow how the virus is reacting in our community.
- Common areas and frequently touched surfaces are being cleaned multiple times daily. We will be spraying weekly with 200GDC Gencie commercial sprayer which kills bacteria and virus on contact with microscopic spikes for up to 14 days. Additional cleaning supplies are available, and employees are required to clean and disinfect touch spot workspaces throughout the workday and student spaces in between classes.
- Hand sanitizer is provided throughout the studio.
- Posters are displayed with reminders on how to prevent the spread of germs.
- Lobby distancing tape markers are applied. One person per bench.




About our new air sanitizing equipment



Aerus Air Purifier installed

The studio has invested \$10,000 in 4 units of the best technology available in air purification. This technology is used in NASA, MLB facilities, and surgery centers. Germs, bacteria and virus are attacked by super oxides that constantly purifying the air in the air and on surfaces in addition to being filtered as well with Hepa Filter and UV light. We are doing all we can to keep everyone safe at Dance Impact.

What you can do:

- Upon entering studio, please enter through the door in which your child will be taking class. Doors are labeled A, B, C according to the 3 rooms.
- Stay home or go home if you or your child are sick or feel like you may be getting sick.
- **All parents must fill out the health survey for your child to submit upon their first class in addition to signing the studio release form. Both of these forms are attached in the email**
- Maintain 6' social distancing practices.
- Wash your hands frequently or use hand sanitizer-bring sanitizer to class
- Cover your nose and mouth when sneezing or coughing.
- Avoid touching your face.
- Replace handshakes with head nods and waves.
- Avoid touching surfaces inside the studio. Bring a towel to wipe sweat instead of touching face.
- Be kind. Understand that this is a stressful time for everyone, and an extra bit of kindness right now can go a long way.




What happens when student arrives:

- Wait for Green poster in the window of your child's class meaning coast is clear and your child may enter the studio. Red sign means class is in session, do not enter yet.
- Students will take their shoes off in the lobby to avoid bringing extra germs into the dance room
- Student will be instructed to use hand sanitizer or wash hands upon arrival
- We prefer each child bring their own sanitizer but it will also be provided should your child not have one.
- Student's temperature will be taken
- Student will be instructed to place their dance bag in a cubby, take of shoes, bring their **water bottle, sanitizer, and towel** to their dance space
- At the end of class students will be reminded once again sanitize hands
- Students will be brought out to the side walk one student at a time dismissed to parents



Frequently Asked Questions



Can my child continue to zoom from home?


Yes, the studio has installed TV's and cameras in all 3 dance rooms to enable those students who are not ready to come back to the studio to still be able to participate and engage in class. The teachers will still be able to provide feedback to your child on our TV screen.



Is it safe to return to dance?

We are taking every precaution to ensure our studio is safe. We are following federal health and safety guidelines as well as guidance from our state and local governments. As mandates change in our county, our policies will change as well.

Frequently Asked Questions, cont.



Does my child or I have to wear a mask?

Unless required by a state or local order, students and employees are not required to wear a mask during class. We are requesting that masks be worn in the lobby when 6' distancing is not possible. In classrooms, masks/shields are recommended to have as an added protection for all, mostly for the times that they may be unable to keep 6' distancing such as going across the floor. Employees are wearing face shields or masks to catch droplets while speaking. (Lobby is closed except for new studio parents or those needing assistance at the desk)



How will student drop off/pick up be handled?

We ask that parents use social distancing in the parking lot and wait outside your vehicle or on sidewalk for your child to be brought out. Green sign in window means it is clear to enter. Red sign means please wait until class has been dismissed.

Frequently Asked Questions, cont.



Do I have to answer medical questions?

All employees, students and visitors will be required to fill out a health screening survey and answer questions regarding COVID-19 and symptoms before entering our buildings. For an unknown time, temperatures will be taken upon entry into the classroom.



About sick employees

We will now have a more relaxed policy on sick absences for our employees. We do not want them to come to work if they feel sick, or feel like they are getting sick. Within reason as company is afforded to, employees' pay will not be reduced for having to stay home with sickness or sickness due to Covid-19. We ask that all families be patient with circumstances that may require us to cancel classes due to not being able to have a substitute instructor every time an instructor is ill. We will always do our best to find a substitute, but anticipating possible more frequent absences, this may not always be possible and a make up class will be provided at a later date.

Frequently Asked Questions, cont.

How will positive cases of COVID-19 be handled in the studio?



Despite all precautionary measures, there is always a risk of exposure to communicable diseases. Should an employee or student contract COVID-19 and expose others in our studio, we will immediately inform all employees and clients of the possible exposure. A thorough cleaning of the studio and fog spraying will occur before re-opening. We ask for patience with having to make up missed classes at a later date in this circumstance.

What if my child or someone starts to feel sick during class?



Instructor will place a mask on, sanitize hands, give the child a mask to put on and ask the child to go into the bathroom, wash hands, and be supervised until their parent can come. All pick ups in this situation should be from the back studio door. Should the child have a fever, the rest of the class must leave the classroom to the lobby or supervised outside until air has circulated through a full air change purification (15 minutes).
